**The Dedication of the Basilica of St. John**

**Lateran** Today marks the anniversary of the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome. It is in this church that the chair (cathedra) of the Pope as Bishop of Rome stands. The church was built on land owned by the Laterani family and was dedicated on November 9, 324 by Pope Sylvester I. It is honored as "the mother and head of all churches in Rome and the world." Known first as the Church of the Savior, it was later dedicated to St. John the Baptist. On this day we pray especially for the Pope and the unity of the Catholic Church throughout the world.
