World Youth Day Madrid 2011 Bishop Kevin Rhoades invites the youth of the diocese, ages 16-30, to join him at **World Youth Day 2011** from **August 10 to 22, 2011**, in Madrid, Spain. The spiritual pilgrimage will include a two-day retreat experience in Lourdes, a brief visit to Loyola, an overnight in Burgos, and the World Youth Day activities in Madrid. The approximate cost will be \$3,000. A non-refundable \$350 deposit is due by December 31. Quarterly payments of \$400 will begin January 15, 2010. Payment in full by April 15, 2011. Volunteers Needed The South Central District Office of the PA Department of Health is seeking volunteers to staff Vaccination Clinics throughout the district for the H1N1 flu vaccine. This District covers 13 counties, including Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lebanon, Mifflin, Perry and York, which are part of the Diocese. These clinics will function under the auspices of the PA Department of Health and will be staffed with medical and non-medical volunteers. Clinics will be operational from mid-November to mid-December on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Specific dates for administering the vaccine cannot be given until the vaccine is available.

Medically trained personnel will serve as vaccine administrators and onsite medical staff. These volunteers may include retired, but still licensed, practitioners, certified paramedics, nurses, physician assistants and certified pharmacists. Medical, nursing and allied health students, working under their academic supervision may also be able to assist.

Non-medical personnel will be needed to provide administrative and logistics support, including traffic control, parking, registration, restocking supplies, and organizing lines of people waiting for their vaccination. Individuals are asked to commit to a 6-hour shift, if possible. Commitments for smaller shifts will also be accepted.
