**SOLEMN EUCHARISTIC DEVOTIONS 2010** Next weekend on **Sunday, March 7**, we will open the annual Solemn Eucharistic Devotions in Good Shepherd Parish. Commonly referred to as 40 Hours, this is our yearly opportunity as a parish community to celebrate the presence of Our Lord in our midst in the Eucharist in a special way.
