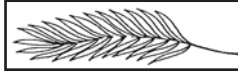

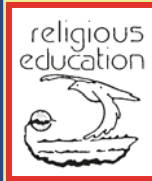

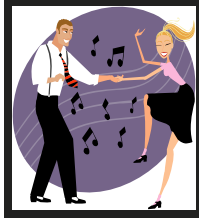
**WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY**
