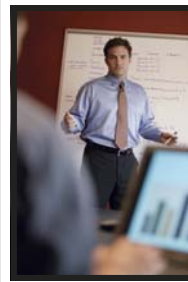

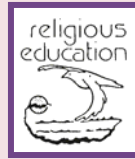

Please come join us once a month for a time of prayer and spiritual support for each other as we seek strength through God's Loving Grace in prayer and praise.

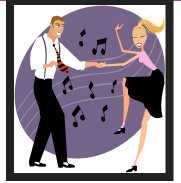
