GOOD HAPPENINGS FROM GOOD SHEPHERD SCHOOL

Alex Cominsky was recently notified by the National Geographic Society that he is one of the semi-finalists eligible to compete in the 2010 Pennsylvania Geographic Bee sponsored by Google and Plum Creek. Bees were held in schools with fourth through eighth grade students throughout the state to determine each school's Geography Bee winner. School-level winners then took a qualifying test, which they submitted to the National Geographic Society. In each of the 50 states, as well as the District of Columbia, the Department of Defense Dependents Schools, and U.S. territories, the National Geographic Society invited the students with the top 100 scores to compete at the state level. The 2010 Pennsylvania Geographic Bee will be held in the upcoming weeks at Penn State's University Park Campus. Alex has the potential of winning \$100 at the state level, along with the National Geographic Collegiate Atlas of the World and a trip to Washington, D.C., where he would represent Pennsylvania in the national finals at the National Geographic Society Headquarters in May. In addition to competing at the state level, by virtue of his winning the school level Geography Bee, Alex will also represent Good Shepherd School at the Diocesan Geography Bee this month. 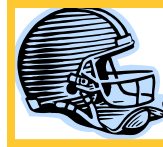
