By enrolling in NetCharge, our online donation system, parishioners can set up automatic recurring donations to Good Shepherd Parish. The system is similar to ones used to simplify bill paying or for making donations to other charities. The process is user-friendly, efficient, and secure.

A record of your contribution will be recorded on your account online (which you will be able to review) as well as in the parish records. Please note your donation will be listed on your credit card or bank statement with "NetCharge" shown as the payee. However, be assured that your donations will be received by Good Shepherd Parish.

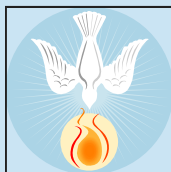
