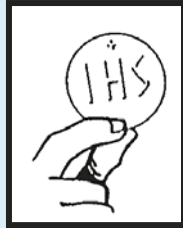

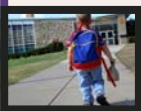
"Teen Disciples for Christ"
