Guests of Bishop McFadden have also been invited to a Vesper Service on Tuesday, August 17, at Good Shepherd Church. The service will not be televised.

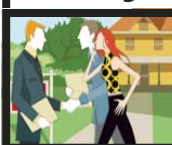
